To: All Staff, Parents, Students and Community Members

The Three Rivers School District has reached an agreement with its licensed teaching staff that best addresses the needs of everyone involved considering the lack of adequate funding provided by the State of Oregon. As a result of that agreement, there are some changes that will be taking place beginning December 4, 2012, and while it is our hope that students and families notice little to no impact, we want to be sure you are informed. Beginning on Tuesday, December 4, 2012, students at the high school level will receive an additional fifteen minutes per day of classroom instruction. It was important to teachers that instructional time with students be protected as much as possible. To make that happen, schedules are being created at the middle and high schools to accommodate the 15 minutes.

Beginning December 4th, all high schools will start class at 8:40 a.m. and end at 3:35 p.m. Lincoln Savage and Fleming Middle Schools will start class at 8:50 a.m. and end at 3:20 p.m. Lorna Byrne Middle School will start class at 8:45 a.m. and end at 3:20 p.m. **There will be no schedule changes for any elementary schools or**

Applegate School.

You will notice no difference in the pick-up time of your student on the morning busses, but there is a possibility that your middle and high school students may be dropped off five to ten minutes later at the end of the day. There will be no changes in the drop-off times for elementary schools and Applegate School.

More immediately, there is a calendar change that affects all students, and subsequently the teachers. Winter Break for students and teachers will begin on December 20, Instead of December 24, giving families more time to prepare for the holiday season and more time to travel. Days that were previously scheduled for staff development days, January 18 and April 19, will be reinstated as days students will attend classes.

An updated calendar is being sent home to all families and will be available on the District's website at www.threerivers.k12.or.us. Thank you for your flexibility and understanding. If you have any questions whatsoever, please do not hesitate to call your school.

ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS
Straight Line Routes For:

Illinois Valley, Lorna Byrne, Evergreen:

In the event of adverse weather conditions parents are advised to tune in to Radio Stations KRWQ, KAJQ, KLDL, KBOY and TV Stations KOBI (5), KDRV (12), KTVL (10) or the Three Rivers School District Web Page (www.threerivers.k12.or.us) for information on school bus schedules, delays or closures.

Sometimes weather conditions leave some roads blocked or unsafe to travel but school is still being held. Under these circumstances "straight line routes" will be run. This is the information you will get on the web page or radio/TV stations.

When straight line routes are run the roads affected are listed below.

If you live on one of the roads the buses cannot travel, you may bring your student to the nearest intersection of the main road traveled. This will also be the stop for the afternoon drop off.
