


## Wood Dale District 7 Vision Statement

students will be resilient, lifelong learners



## Wood Dale District 7 Mission Statement

We will collaborate with all families to implement high quality instruction and provide engaging learning experiences, empowering each student to reach their full potential, in a safe and supportive environment.



In the area of STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT, the Board will ensure the staff has the resources needed to provide high quality instruction & engaging learning experiences for each student.

- A. By June 2021, 90% of K-1st grade students will be on-grade level in English decoding skills on the MAP Fluency assessment.
- B. By June 2021, 90% of K-1st grade students will be on-grade level in Spanish decoding skills on the MAP Fluency assessment.
- C. By June 2021, 80% of 2nd grade students will be reading on grade level in English and 80% in Spanish on the MAP Fluency assessment.
- D. By June 2021, using the Lucy Calkins Narrative Reading Progression rubric in the area of retelling/summary/synthesis within text the percentage of 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders performing in the proficient range will increase by 10% (administered in English).
- E. By June 2021, using the claim, evidence, reasoning teacher created rubric the percentage of 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students performing in the proficient range will increase by 10% (administered in English).
- F. By June 2021, 80% of K-8 grade students will increase their math achievement from the pre-post assessment.

In the area of FAMILY & COMMUNITY RELATIONS, the Board will provide the staff with the resources needed to increase District 7's level of engagement with all school families and the local community.

- A. Implement the use of personal contact and surveys to identify and address any needs (nutrition, health, mental health, attendance and academic) of our students and their families during the pandemic.
- B. Provide family/parent education information & resources to assist families in adapting and supporting their students with hybrid/remote learning during the pandemic.
- C. Assure community awareness of the teaching and learning programs in place at Wood Dale District 7 during the pandemic.

In the area of FINANCE & OPERATIONS, the Board will ensure the budget and financial plan is aligned with the district's vision, mission & goals, while respecting the financial resources of the community.

- A. Develop a detailed Capital Project Plan for the next five years, using the 10 Year Life Safety Survey as a guide.
- B. Enhance communication of school financial data to district stakeholders.
- C. Review & select projects to complete from the operations & maintenance plan, to ensure an engaging and safe learning environment for all students and staff.
