Elementary End-of-Year Report:

- Total number of students decreased by 3 but numbers in K-2 decreased significantly (from 28 to 8 students) as those students use ADSIS mainly for behavior services. Most of the students in grades 3-6 received Reading services - this could be due to the reading initiative and the use of Fastbridge to screen students K-8.
- The number of students referred for Special Education services increased from 2 to 7 students.
- Brooke Orazem did a wonderful job this year but will be replaced by Lynn Jerman. She will be incorporating a program called Freckle with her students and it will also be used by other teachers for reading and math.

High School End of Year Report:

- Total number of students using ADSIS in the High School increased from 29 to 35 students but we did have five students graduate from the program; most of which came from the 7th grade.
- The High School ADSIS program focuses a lot on improving academic behaviors (completing assignments, turning in work, etc.) but we are hoping to focus on Math and Reading services with students that need it more directly next year.
- Using Fastbridge to screen students in grades 7-8 is helping us to identify students who need assistance in Reading and Math; which is why the numbers increased this year.

For next school year:

- The Grant for next year has already been approved. Our budget spreadsheet needed some tweaking so we are waiting to hear back from MDE on its approval.
- We will continue to invite current participants in the program before school starts so they can benefit from the program when school resumes. Fastbridge and MCA scores will be used to indicate any other students who need to be invited into the program.

I am currently working on the End-of-Year report and Student Hour Sheet that is required for submission to be in the ADSIS program (due September 15th).
