## **Baseball**

The Brownwood baseball program had a roster of 48 players, and we graduated 3 seniors. The varsity compiled a record of 9 wins and 16 losses finishing 3rd in district 6-4A with a 6-6 record earning bi-district playoff berth.

The varsity had a roster of 18 players, the JV Maroon had a roster of 14 and the JV White had a roster of 16. The JV Maroon finished the season with a 10 – 9 record and the JV White finished the year with a 7-7 record.

### **Powerlifting:**

The boys had a successful season, competing in three meets up until the regional meet. The fourth meet, a last chance qualifier, was cancelled due to weather. Fourteen different boys competed in at least one meet, with most competing in at least two

meets. As a team we placed 2nd at all three meets. We had eight lifters qualify for the regional meet, James Evetts, Kaleb Grabast, Isaac Gray, Chance Jones, Easton Judkins, Zaiden Lopez, Quinten McCarty and Damian Sanchez. Chance finished 4th at regionals, while Isaac and Zaiden each finished 5th in their respective weight classes.

The girls team also had a successful season despite our numbers dropping to four lifters. The girls competed in the same three meets as the boys. Ashlyn Harris, Jandrea McVicker, and Mackenzie Welch qualified for the regional meet, while Addison Welch was an alternate. Ashlyn finished 5th, but qualified for the state meet as the top lifter in 4A Region 2, Division 1. She competed against some strong lifters and finished 13th at state.
