- E-rate By the end of 2025, approximately 80% of the district network equipment will be outdated
 - > HISD has contracted with CRW Consulting to prepare the proper documentation for e-rate funding.
 - > HISD Technology has submitted to CRW to request RFPs for network equipment replacement, battery back-up devices (UPSes), and replacement of internal fiber infrastructure on various campuses.
 - ➤ E-rate is a federal Universal Service Schools and Libraries Program, which provides reimbursement for telecommunications and internet access for eligible K-12 schools. HISD qualifies for 60% reimbursement.
- Ongoing video surveillance upgrades and repairs at the various campuses.
 - > Video-based doorbells.
 - > Remote buttons to open doors for receptionists.
- Resolved several door and gate-related issues.
- The Technology Department closed 455 work orders in October 2025.

Technology Roadmap

- Upgrade/replace the server racks in the District Network Operations Center
- Replace and upgrade the public paging system at the East Elementary School.
- Replace and upgrade the public paging system at the Junior High.
- Streamlining daily operational processes and procedures.

Long-term Projects/Goals

- Replacement and upgrade of a district-wide core servers.
 - > HISD core servers have superseded their life expectancy by several years.
- Upgrade of the environmental cooling system in the District Network Operations Center.
- Proactively replace legacy buried fiber optic cabling connecting multiple campuses to ensure continued network reliability and performance.
- Replacement of the existing Telephone System with an industry-standard VOIP system.
- Junior High Auditorium audio equipment replacement, remodel, and stage upgrades.
