It has built in learning objects and goals for each unit.</p>

Having these materials will help us fill in the gaps to prepare them and give them the most variety of cultural content to be more knowledgeable before the AP or IB exams the next year and be the most communicative with the 4 language skills, as possible (writing, listening, speaking &amp; reading).</p> <p>For teacher use, it has similar unit topics to our current units and therefore makes the transition somewhat easier allowing me to focus more on students' success and less on the tireless creation and adaptation of additional resources and finding supplemental materials.</p>

<b>Other Comments:</b>	While most of the above info sounds great, it's worth mentioning that this book lacks some of the content students currently get in IB Spanish, which they have not yet covered upon exiting level 3 and still need before level 4. There's a good base, lots of quality review and thoroughly covered new concepts for them but also the lack of some other content would potentially affect AP or their overall content level understanding, maybe. Additionally, I did some research by asking teachers who use this series for earlier levels how they felt and it has many issues in lower level curriculum so I'm apprehensive to adopt it for upper levels too and we'd likely not commit to it for 1-3 either so it would lack consistency in style for students in the future.

<b>Other Comments:</b>	<p>This series has the most efficient and at level approach for students to follow based on what they already know. While having two texts is not the norm, this combo would help bridge the gap between what Novi doesn't learn by Spanish 3 and what they need before AP/IB 2 to be successful on the text. Also, the material combination fits all of the thematic AP and IB topics and is scaffolded for the main purpose of pre-AP and to teach lots of culture and interpersonal communication for students. We have also not received new materials for this course in 20 years so I feel this is a great opportunity to test out the Senderos curriculum, which is by the same company as Imagina, which is the AP textbook, to see if we'd like to move this down the levels in the future or if AP would like to use any of the level 5 resources too. It covers the UbD emphasis we've had at Novi to focus on student-led and driven education with a focus on the national and state standards but is familiar in usability for students and teachers. This would require the least amount of imagination by the teacher to supplement but still allow flexibility to add desired materials as wanted instead of as needed.</p>
