Regular Meeting
SCHOOL BOARD
AUGUST 19, 2025

Chair Yang called the meeting to order at 6:01 PM with the following present: Chair Yang, Vice Chair C. Anderson, Clerk Livingston, Treasurer Martens, Director Swor and Superintendent Tucci Osorio.
Absent: Directors Nitardy and Yener.

Others present were: Andrew Beaton, Assistant Superintendent; Tricia St. Michaels, Assistant Superintendent; Josh Anderson, Director of Finance & Technology; and May Her, Executive Assistant.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Livingston moved and Martens seconded the following motion, which carried on a 5 – 0 vote:
THAT the agenda be approved as presented.

During the public comment portion of the meeting, Greg Schiffler addressed the Board with concerns regarding the boys swim and dive team; and Sam Rosemark commented on the levy.

The Consent Agenda was considered. Swor requested that Item IV.I., Grant Awards, be removed for discussion. C. Anderson moved and Martens seconded the following resolution, which carried on a 5 – 0 vote:

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No. 622 that the following Consent Agenda Items, IV.A. - IV.H., be approved as written, and a copy of the agenda items is attached to the minutes.

Swor highlighted the American Indian Education language grant. Swor moved and Martens seconded the following resolution, which carried on a 5 – 0 vote:

Beaton gave an overview of the referendum.

St. Michaels presented the first formal reading the following thirteen propose policies revisions first reviewed at the August 12, 2025 work study session: 414(Mandated Reporting of Child Neglect or Physical or Sexual Abuse); 416(Drug, Alcohol, and Cannabis Testing); 418(Drug Free Workplace/Drug Free School); 425(Staff Development); 501(School Weapons Policy); 503(Student Attendance); 515(Protection & Privacy of Pupil Records); 516(Student Medication and Telehealth); 606.5(Library Materials); 613(Graduation Requirements); 620(Credit for Learning); 621(Literacy and The READ Act); and 624 (Online Learning Options). There will be one more reading followed by proposed revision at the September 23, 2025 business meeting.

Tucci Osorio provided an update regarding back to school plans.

Yang read an executive summary of Tucci Osorio's recent evaluation for the 2024-2025 school year, noting that she was ranked exceeding expectations as Superintendent of the North St. Paul-Maplewood-Oakdale School District. Yang and the Board have continued confidence in Tucci Osorio for her leadership and appreciates her commitment to 622.

Martens moved and C. Anderson seconded the following resolution, which carried on a 5 – 0 vote:

RESOLUTION RE.DESIGNATING POLLING LOCATION FOR THE NOVEMBER 4,2025 SPECIAL ELECTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No. 622, State of Minnesota, as follows:

1. On December 13, 2022, the School Board adopted a Resolution Establishing Polling Places and Combined Polling Places for Certain Multiple Precincts and Designating Hours for School District Elections When No Other Election Is Being Held in the School District (the "Resolution").
2. The Resolution designated the following location as a polling place for the City of Oakdale, Precinct 2: Oakdale City Hall, 1584 Hadley Avenue North, Oakdale, Minnesota.
3. The School District has recently been informed by Washington County election officials that the Oakdale City Hall is currently under construction and will not be available for use as a polling location for the School District's special election, which has been called and will be held on November 4,2025.

Martens moved and Livingston seconded the following resolution, which carried on a 5 – 0 vote:
