Detailed description of elementary reading program aligned to Science of Reading	The Brinkley School District has a comprehensive school curriculum that has the components of literacy foundation elements--phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension embedded. We also use Heggerty to address phonemic awareness and phonics instruction.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> How will the teacher engage students in direct instruction in the Science of Reading? 	K-2 students will log in daily for synchronous reading instruction reading and 3-6 students will log in at a minimum three times a week for synchronous reading instruction.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> How will teachers engage students in small group instruction at least 3 times a week for K-2? 	Our virtual students have the option to come onsite for literacy and math instruction. K-2 students will also be required to log into Zoom or Google Meet daily during reading instruction and 3-6 for a minimum of three times a week. The students online will have a designated time to work with the teacher in small groups just as the students onsite.
