RE: **IMA AND TEKS CERTIFICATION, 2015-2016**

As outlined by Instructional Materials Allotment (IMA) fund procedures, TEA is requiring districts to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the Commissioner that students have access to instructional materials for each subject in the required curriculum that cover all the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills. Districts will be unable to submit any requisitions or disbursements until the certification has been signed and submitted to the Texas Education Agency. The Instructional Materials Allotment and TEKS Certification form must be presented before the local board of trustees. The superintendent, local board president and the board secretary are required to sign the form before submission to the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

As a guideline, Eagle Pass ISD only adopts instructional materials that have been reviewed and adopted by the State Board of Education and cover 100% of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for the subject area. All instructional materials requisitioned or purchased by the district with the district's IMA fund are identified and tracked by our TIPWeb Instructional Materials Management System. Attached is the Instructional Materials Allotment TEKS Certification Form for the 2015-2016 school year.
