Background Information:

- In 2023, the Texas Legislature passed HB3033, amending Chapter 552 of the Texas Government Code (Texas Public Information Act) to clarify the definition of business days and require the designation of nonbusiness days under the TPIA by local governments.
- The statute defines 'business day' as a day *other* than a Saturday or Sunday, a national holiday, or a state holiday. A governmental body is required to identify no more than 10 days each calendar year that its administrative offices are closed or operating with minimum staffing as nonbusiness days.
- This recommended calendar marks national holidays, state holidays, and KISD designated dates as nonbusiness days for the purposes of calculating deadlines for the TPIA process.
