In your application, you stated: "Club America is Turning Point USA's high school club organization that is non-profit and non-partisan." After reviewing information on Turning Point USA, I can confirm it is a non-profit organization; however, there is no indication that it is non-partisan. In fact, the organization publicly promotes conservative political views and policies.

I've included a short excerpt from Wikipedia to illustrate this point. While I recognize Wikipedia is not always the most authoritative source, I was unable to access Turning Point's official website due to our district's internet filter. Nevertheless, the available information clearly demonstrates that the organization is associated with a political group.

You are welcome to meet with me to discuss this matter further. However, unless you can provide credible documentation demonstrating that the organization is truly non-partisan, my decision will remain the same. Under **Policy 3225**, the district cannot approve or sponsor clubs that promote or are affiliated with political groups. Allowing one political club would require us to allow all, which is precisely why this policy exists.
