- Students must be in good standing at the library.
- Students may have <u>no</u> office referrals for the trimester.
- Students may have <u>no</u> suspensions off the bus for the trimester.
- 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grades only must have at least 80% of their AR/ Reading goal for the trimester.
