

Lunch would likely be one hour in length, including the time allocated for lunch and recess. Students will be unmasked while they eat lunch supervised in either their classrooms or other common spaces, which may include outdoors, hallways, foyer areas, or other unconventional (but safe) locations. Students will continue to be socially distanced according to ISBE and IDPH guidance during the lunch period. Additionally, the lunch period will likely look different in each building due to how the facility is configured. Please consider this information as you respond to the guestions below.

Roosevelt, due to student density, would have the instructional day extended, but remain on a hybrid schedule.




If the District allows it, would you opt to have your child go home for lunch/recess each day?


If District 90 requires additional lunch supervision beyond its capacity to provide it, would you be interested in volunteering to help supervise students during lunch/recess?




Once the District returns to a full-day, in-person model after Spring Break, will your child attend school in-person for the remainder of the school year?


