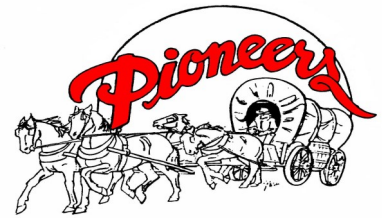

## Immunizations:

You may have received a letter recently from the office notifying you to update your student's immunizations. Immunizations are required by law for students attending public and private schools in Oregon. The exclusion day and deadline to have your student's vaccinations updated and turned into the office is February 21, 2018. If you have not updated your child's immunizations the school is required by law to exclude your child from school until documentation is received. To ensure that your student does not miss school please make sure his/her immunizations are complete and/or a nonmedical exemption is filed.
