We are going on the radio on each weekday in order to reach students who are unable to fulfill their remote duties due to tech/internet issues and other miscellaneous issues that will inevitably spring up as we go to distance learning. The town of Browning, along with the larger Blackfoot Confederacy, has reached out to the BNAS dept and with absolute glee that we are doing this. I believe it is a powerful response to distant learning.

The YouTube page will also be uploading more content. We will average one new video every few days. These will always be available for future use.

The BNAS department is putting together a 'Language Packet' for students/community. It will include lists and flash cards. Lists include: numbers, colors, vocabulary, stories, etc...
