**TOPIC: RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PRECINCTS, DESIGNATING POLLING PLACES & DESIGNATING HOURS FOR VOTING FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS NOT HELD ON THE DAY OF A STATEWIDE ELECTION**

**BACKGROUND:** State law requires us to update our precinct locations as a result of the legislative redistricting process.

**PROCESS:** After consulting with election officials in Washington County, we are recommending a change in Precinct 5 from the District Offices of School District 831 to the Headwaters Service Center located at 19955 Forest Road N., Forest Lake, Minnesota. This change was made at the April 18, 2013 School Board meeting.

Two new changes include moving from Scandia Elementary to Scandia Community Center, Columbus township is now referred to as City of Columbus.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopted resolution establishing combined polling places for school district elections not held on the day of a statewide election.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PRECINCTS, DESIGNATING POLLING PLACES  
AND DESIGNATING HOURS DURING WHICH THE POLLING PLACES WILL  
REMAIN OPEN FOR VOTING FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS NOT HELD  
ON THE DAY OF A STATEWIDE ELECTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No. 831, as follows:

1. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the precincts and polling places for school district elections are those precincts or parts of precincts located within the boundaries of the school district which have been established by the cities or towns located in whole or in part within the school district. The Board hereby confirms those precincts and polling places so established by those municipalities.
2. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the board may combine several precincts into a single precinct for school elections not held on the day of a statewide election. The following combined school district voting precincts are hereby established for all school district special and general elections not held on the same day as a statewide election:

Precinct 1 encompasses all territory in ISD 831 located in the township of May and city of Scandia, Washington County, MN.

Precinct 2 encompasses all territory in ISD 831 located in the city of Lino Lakes, Anoka County, MN.

Precinct 3 encompasses all territory in ISD 831 located in the township of Linwood, Anoka County, MN.

Precinct 4 encompasses all territory in ISD 831 located in the cities of Columbus, East Bethel and Ham Lake, Anoka County, MN.

Precinct 5 encompasses all territory in ISD 831 located in the cities of Forest Lake and Hugo, Washington County, MN.

Precinct 6 encompasses all territory in ISD 831 located in the cities of Chisago City, Stacy, and Wyoming, Chisago County, MN.

3. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the following polling places are hereby designated for said combined precincts for all school district special and general elections not held on the same day as a statewide election:

- Precinct 1: Scandia Community Center

- Precinct 2: Lino Lakes Elementary School

Lino Lakes, MN
- Precinct 3: Linwood Elementary School  
21900 Typo Creek Dr. NE  
Wyoming, MN
- Precinct 4: Columbus Elementary School  
17345 Notre Dame St  
Forest Lake, MN
- Precinct 5: Headwaters Service Center  
19955 Forest Road N.  
Forest Lake, MN
- Precinct 6: Wyoming Elementary School  
25701 Forest Blvd. N.  
Wyoming, MN

4. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.09, the polling places will remain open for voting for school district elections between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m.
5. The Clerk is directed to prepare a map illustrating the boundaries of each combined precinct, to post the map of the combined precincts in the administrative offices of the school district and to file a copy of the map with the County Auditor. The Clerk shall also file a certified copy of this resolution with said County Auditor.
