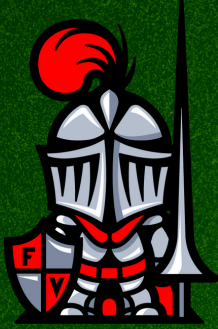

INCLEMENT WEATHER



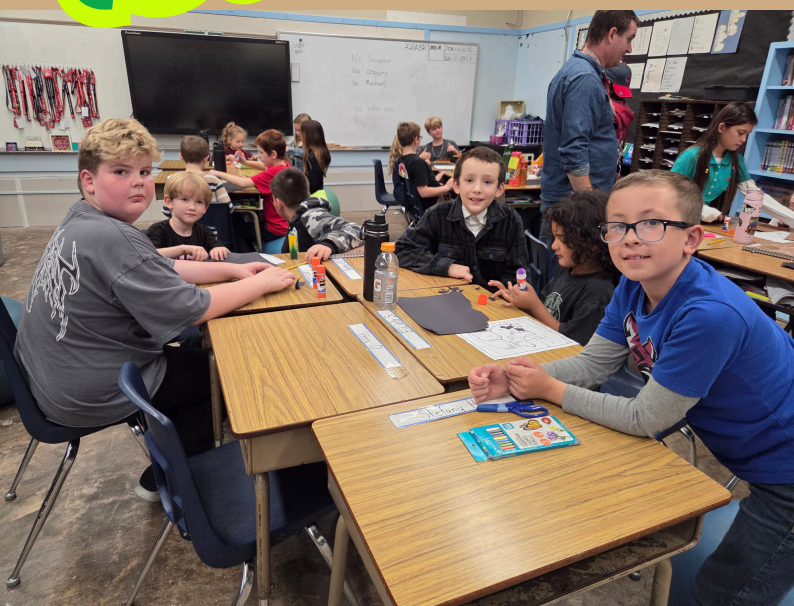
As we reach the winter season, we want to take a moment and explain how school delays and closures are determined due to weather. The district's number one priority is the safety of our students and staff. Inclement weather can put our students and staff in danger and we want to make sure that we have as much information as possible when making the decision to close schools.

The district coordinates with First Student Busing to determine the viability of our buses making it to school safely in the conditions and district leadership are out on the roads to assess the travel situation in each of our three attendance areas. This helps us decide if a delay or closure is necessary for the entire district or just one attendance area. We take into account the safety of the travel routes of our buses, staff commute, and student safety for those that drive to school.

It is always our goal to make any decision by 5:15 am to alert staff and students. ParentSquare will contact you at the number that we have in our system by text and by call. We do our best to reach out to all of the media outlets(some stations are better than others at posting accurate information), post to our social media accounts, and send our message to staff via email and phone calls if a delay or closure is happening.

For those of you that are from the area, you may understand that this is unfortunately not an exact science trying to predict the weather in our region, with all of the factors that go into the decision and forecasts that are available from the National Weather Service.

McKinney-Vento Program

Support for Families Experiencing Housing Instability

The McKinney-Vento Act ensures that children and youth experiencing homelessness are provided uninterrupted access to education and services despite the lack of a fixed, adequate, nighttime place of residence.

Housing instability may look like...

- ⇒ Doubled-up with others due to loss of housing or economic hardship
- ⇒ Living in a motel or shelter/transitional home
- ⇒ Living in a car, tent, etc.
- ⇒ Living in unsafe or inadequate conditions such as a house or building without electricity or plumbing.

Support may include...

- ⇒ Immediate school enrollment
- ⇒ Remaining in school of origin
- ⇒ Transportation to and from school of origin
- ⇒ School supplies and clothing
- ⇒ Participation in school activities and programs
- ⇒ Support from your school's Family Advocate

Programa de McKinney-Vento

Asistencia para las familias que estén pasando inestabilidad en la vivienda

La Ley McKinney-Vento garantiza que los niños y jóvenes sin hogar se les proporcione acceso ininterrumpido a la educación y a los servicios a pesar de la falta de una vivienda nocturna fija y adecuada.

La inestabilidad de la vivienda puede tener aspecto de...

- ⇒ Estar viviendo con otros debido a la pérdida de vivienda o dificultades económicas
 - ⇒ Estar viviendo en un motel o refugio/lugar transicional
 - ⇒ Estar viviendo en un coche, tienda de campaña, etc.
 - ⇒ Estar viviendo en lugares inseguros o en condiciones inadecuadas
- como en una casa o edificio sin electricidad o sin fontanería

Los servicios de asistencia pueden incluir...

- ⇒ Inscripción escolar inmediata
- ⇒ Permanecer en la escuela de origen
- ⇒ Transporte hacia y desde la escuela de origen
- ⇒ Útiles escolares y ropa
- ⇒ Participación en actividades y programas escolares
- ⇒ Apoyo de parte del partidario familiar de su escuela
