- Final Report of Summer Offerings through American Rescue Plan grant:
 - Weekly Picnics - We served approximately 625 lunches between Crosby & Emily this summer!
 - End of Summer Event - Saturday, August 27th: "Surviving Your Environment": A total of 48 people attended this event with about 25 staying through the keynote presentation. Weather likely played a factor in attendance but overall, we are very pleased with the outcome.
