Dear School Community, **RE:** School Calendar and Reduction Days this year

Thank you for your patience regarding the calendar and the ending date for school this year. Even though it does not look like spring with all of the rain, I know that during this season of the year people begin to get both excited and a little anxious about planning end of the year events. Not knowing the official last day of school adds an extra load to the planning process. As soon as we know definitively how many days we are able to restore this year, we will send out an immediate notification.

I want to share with you what we know for sure, and when we hope to know the rest. I hope this information will help everyone in their planning process.

### What we know:

- Graduation at all three high schools will be on the days and times previously scheduled. Graduation will not change.
- Every budget projection has us restoring at least two of the five school days meaning students will be • in school at least until June 4<sup>th</sup>. Teachers would then have a clerical day on June 7<sup>th</sup>.

When we hope to know the rest:

- We should receive an updated payment estimate for this year on May 17<sup>th</sup> which means we should be • able to officially announce the last day of school on or before May 21<sup>st</sup>.
- There are four possible scenarios for the end of school: •
- As stated earlier, the last day for students is June 4<sup>th</sup> and teachers have a clerical day on June 7<sup>th</sup>.
  The last day for students is June 7<sup>th</sup> and teachers have a clerical day on June 8<sup>th</sup>.
  The last day for students is June 8<sup>th</sup> and teachers have a clerical day on June 9<sup>th</sup>.
  The last day for students is June 9<sup>th</sup> and teachers have a clerical day on June 9<sup>th</sup>.

Everyone will know by May 21<sup>st</sup>. If you have to plan an end of the year event with certainty before May 21<sup>st</sup>, I believe your best bet is to plan it for June 4<sup>th</sup> knowing that students may be attending school some of the following week.
