They were the 30-6A District Champions with a record of 9-1. In the playoffs the Eagles made another amazing run to the 4th round of the state playoffs. This year's Regional Semifinals playoff run marked the 3rd consecutive year the Eagles have reached this stage. During their playoff run they were Bi-District, Area, and Regional Quarterfinal Champions compromising an impressive 6 playoff wins. The Eagles spectacular season catapulted them to set a new Eagle Pass High School baseball record with 27 wins, many of those against top ranked teams. Their season record was an outstanding 27 wins and 13 loses, earning them a top 20 ranking among all 249 6A high schools in the state of Texas. Leading the Eagles in All District selections was pitcher Hector "Rorro" Buentello as Co-New Comer of the Year, pitcher Donovan Becerra 1st Team All District Unanimous, center fielder Issac Stanwick 1st Team All District Unanimous, short stop Robert De La Garza 1st Team All District Unanimous, first baseman Derek Ruiz 1st Team All District Unanimous, pitcher Alex Paniagua 1st Team All District, left fielder Aidan Lopez 1st Team All District, second baseman Luis Kancheff 1st Team All District, designated hitter Izhar Mauricio 1st Team All District, third baseman Tavare Chavez All District Honorable Mention, right fielder Miguel "Mikey" Kypuros All District Honorable Mention and Coach of the Year Reynol Mendoza.

The Eagles also represented well in the Academic All District achievements with 7 players: Robert De La Garza, Aidan Lopez, Issac Stanwick, Luis Kancheff, Tavare Chavez, Omar Rodriguez, and Jose Duran.
