Admission of Resident Students

<u>A Ss</u>chool-age students who lives within the district attendance area <u>between the ages of 5 and 19 shall</u> <u>be allowed to may</u> attend school without paying tuition.

- 4. <u>A Ss</u>tudents who turns 19 years of age during the school year shall continue to be eligible for a free and appropriate public education for the remainder of the school year.
- 2. The Board shall may admit an otherwise eligible students who are is not receiving special education and who have has not yet attained 21 years of age prior to the beginning of the current school year if they he/she are is shown to be in need of additional education in order to receive a diploma or modified diploma. These is students may attend school without paying tuition for the remainder of the school year.
- 3. The Board shall admit <u>an</u> otherwise eligible students who <u>have <u>has</u> not yet attained age 21 prior to the beginning of the current school year if the student is receiving special education services and:</u>
 - a. 1. Has not yet received a regular high school diploma or a modified diploma; or
 - b. <u>2.</u> Has received a modified diploma, an extended diploma or an alternative certificate.

A student with disabilities shall be considered a resident in which the child's parent or guardian resides under criteria identified in Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 339.134.

- 4. <u>A Ss</u>tudents with disabilities voluntarily placed outside the home by their <u>his/her</u> parent <u>or</u> <u>guardian</u> may continue to attend the school the student was attending prior to the placement as a district resident, when the student's parent <u>or guardian</u> and school staff can demonstrate it is in the student's best interest.
- 5. The Board may, based on district criteria, deny regular school admission to <u>a</u> students who <u>have</u> <u>has</u> become <u>a</u> residents <u>student</u> and who <u>are is</u> under expulsion from another <u>school</u> district for reasons other than a weapons policy violation.
- 6. The Board shall deny for at least one calendar year from the date of the expulsion, regular school admission to <u>a</u> students who <u>have <u>has</u> become <u>a</u> residents <u>student</u> and who <u>are is</u> under expulsion from another <u>school</u> district for a weapons policy violation.</u>
- 7. The Board may, based on district criteria, provide alternative programs of instruction to $\underline{\mathbf{a}}$ students expelled for a weapons policy violation.
