SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOAL STATEMENT To enhance the safety, structural integrity, and aesthetic appearance of the Morton West Campus by completing comprehensive tuckpointing, brick repair, and window replacement at identified locations. This project aims to prevent further deterioration of the building envelope, improve energy efficiency, and ensure a safe and welcoming learning environment for students, staff, and the community. The project was publicly bid, and five firms submitted proposals. KR Tech was identified as the lowest responsible bidder with a total bid amount of \$670,000. The next lowest bid was submitted by AGAE Contractors at \$1,141,000.00. To ensure KR Tech fully understood the scope and expectations of the project, district representatives held a follow-up meeting with the firm. KR Tech confirmed their understanding and capacity to complete the required work.
