Rules Governing Right to Read Act



Required by LEARNS

Enhances Right to Read legislation by doubling down on literacy

- Ensures comprehensive high-quality literacy screener for all students in grades K-3
- Establishes literacy coach support for current D and F schools
- Reduces redundancy regarding Science of Reading
- Establishes supports for students not meeting grade 3 reading expectations

Rules Governing Educator Performance



Required by LEARNS

Rewards highly-effective teachers through Merit Teacher Incentive Fund Program

- Establishes process to build capacity for and develop teacher leaders
- Holds superintendents accountable for improving student performance
- Reduces unnecessary bureaucracy by not renewing contracts for ineffective teachers

Rules Governing Community Service and Diploma Requirements



Required by LEARNS

Promotes sense of pride and connection to community

- High school students in public schools to complete 75 hours of community service
- Empowers school districts to oversee and approve community service projects
- Outlines process for students who may need an exemption

Rules Governing Public School Choice



Required by LEARNS

Empowers parents and promotes school choice

- Eliminates 3% limit on school choice applications
- Defines "lack of capacity" for denial of school choice application
- Empowers military families to participate in choice
- Puts school choice transfers into effect immediately
- Outlines process for extra-curricular activities
- Requires districts to notify DESE if more than 20 percent of resident students utilize choice or legal transfer

Rules Governing Petitions for Student Transfers



Required by Act 731 of 2023

Empowers parents to petition State Board regarding transfer denials

- Previous: School district board to board transfers were decided at local level with no appeal process
- NEW: Establishes a process in which State Board serves as final arbiter of legal transfers

Rules Governing School Transformation Contracts



Required by LEARNS

Reimagines Persistently Low Performing Schools

- Allows districts to enter into transformation contract with External Operator (EO)/Charter Management Organization (CMO) to provide operational and educational support
- Provides additional option beyond consolidation, annexation, and reconstitution (Marvell-Elaine School District and Friendship)
- Establishes minimum terms and responsibilities for transformation contract

Rules Governing Overnight Travel and Use of School Restrooms



Required by Act 317 of 2023

Ensures privacy and safety of students in public school restrooms

- Implements statutory requirement for districts and charter schools to designate multiple occupancy restrooms or changing areas based on biological sex at birth
- Allows districts authority to provide reasonable accommodations
- Provides guidance for overnight field trips
- Outlines process for non-compliance

Rules Governing Student Protection Act



Required by Act 653 of 2023

Protects students from abortion referrals

 Updates Arkansas Student Protection Act to prohibit districts and charter schools from knowingly entering transactions with individuals and entities that provide abortion referrals
