

## High School Board Report 5-11-21

### Overview

- Several students participated in the State Forensics competition. Two students earned Bronze. Eight students earned Silver. Five students earned Gold. Congrats to all participants and great job on another successful Forensics season.
- FBLA students participated in the national Lifeskills competition. The group finished 15th out of 25. Students had items to submit prior to the weekend that were scored as part of the competition, from which they were 7th going into the weekend. Saturday was tough competition and worked with judges that had high expectations. 75% of the team were underclassmen and are looking forward to competing in the future. It was a great learning experience and students had a lot of fun competing.
- Spring sports have started consisting of softball, baseball, golf and track. Students and athletes were anxious to begin competition. Seasons will end later than a typical year due to WIAA adjustments to the calendar to accommodate districts that chose to hold fall sports in a spring window.
- Evaluation work continues to identify learning needs that can be addressed during the summer and into next school year. The high school looks at several areas of academic support. A primary category is course credit recovery with a focus on required courses to be completed through summer school or built into student schedules for 2021-22. Communication with identified students and their families will continue throughout the rest of the semester.
