## **ENROLLMENT:**

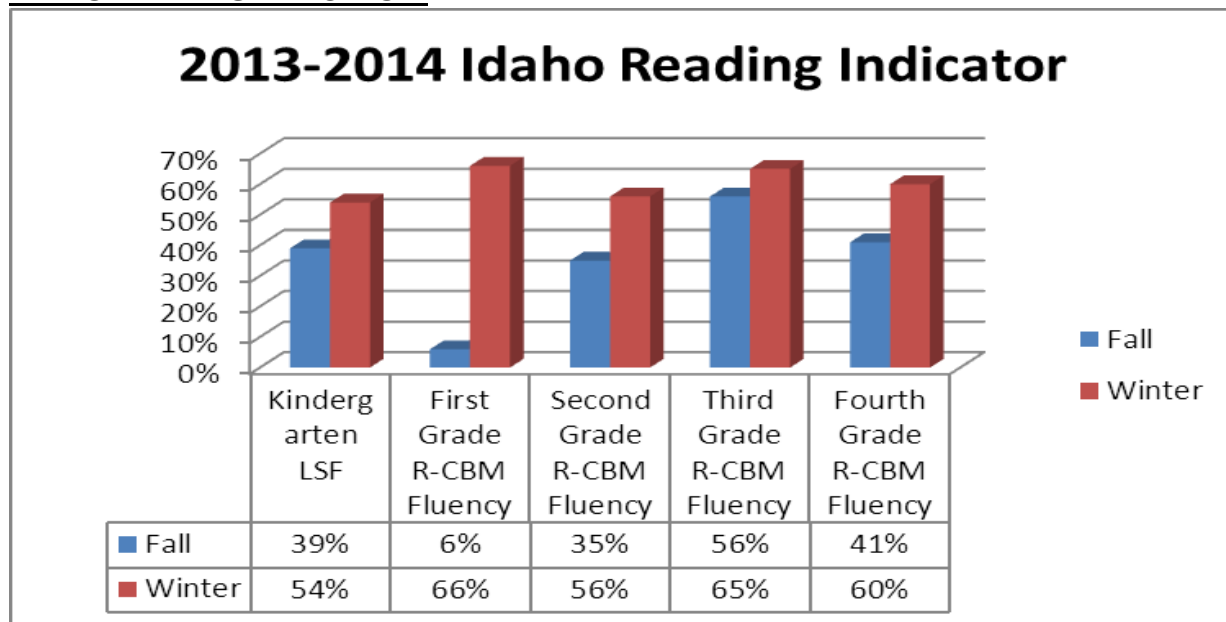

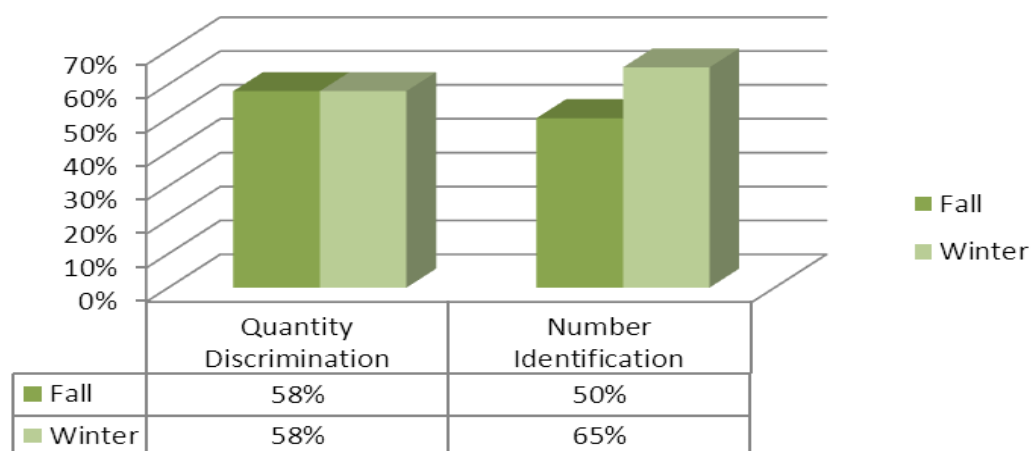

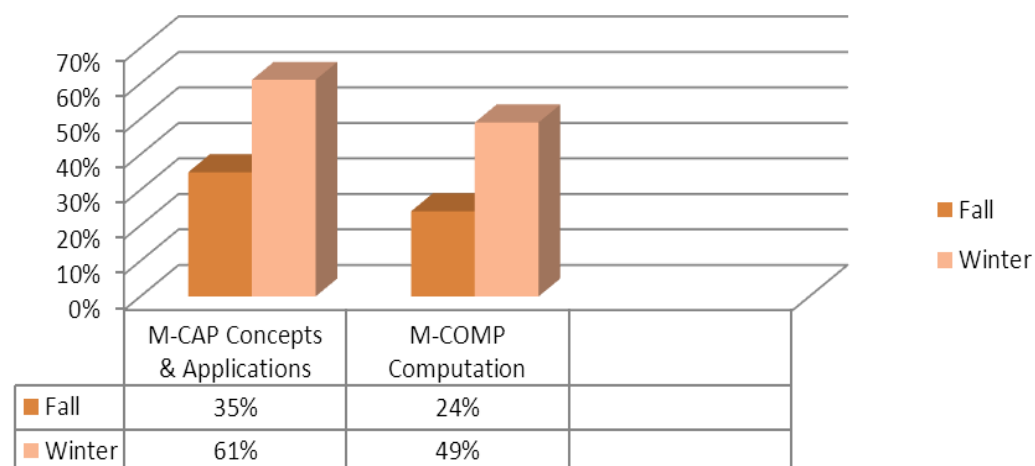
### Kindergarten Math Benchmarks



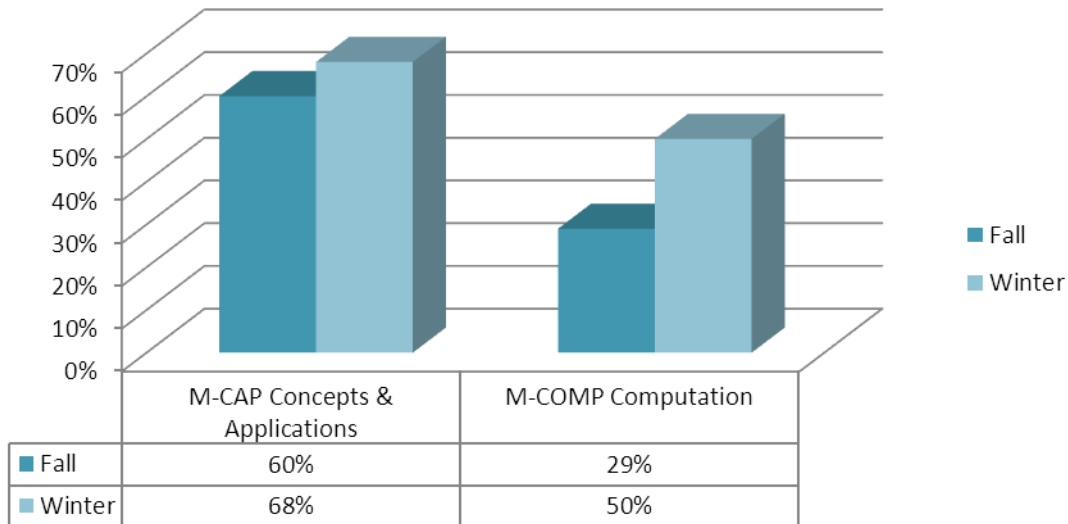
### First Grade Math Benchmark



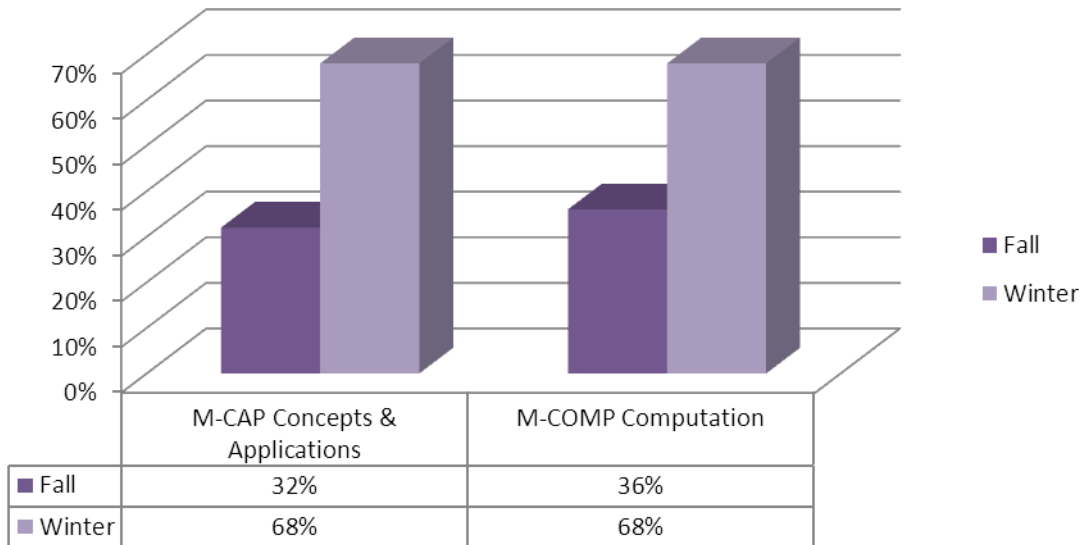
### Second Grade Math Benchmarks
