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# Update from the Babb Elementary Staff on the first month of school

Students K-2 are learning the importance of being kind and how it can make others feel when they are kind. We all learned so much on our recent field trip to First Peoples Buffalo Jump State Park near Ulm, MT. The students learned about how the Blackfeet would trick the buffalo into jumping off the cliffs. They learned about the medicine wheel and how it aligns with the stars. K-2 students learned



and participated in a Native American Game - kick the ball.

In math, Kindergarten students are learning about numbers to 6. First and second graders are learning about place value through additions and subtraction within 20. In writing, Kindergarten students are learning concepts of print: spacing, letters vs. words, and directionality. First and second graders are learning about what makes a sentence. In ELA, Kindergarten is working on listening comprehension, while 1st-2nd graders are learning how to use the text to support their answers

September has been a very busy month for us. In Math, the 3rd are learning multi-digit addition and subtraction with regrouping. The 5th are finding equivalent fractions and comparing fractions on a number line. 6th are working on decimal multi-digit multiplication. We were happy to have Mary Buck visit us this month. In Social Studies 3rd are learning about family relationships. The 5th and 6th are learning about our government. We went hiking at Many Glacier with the park rangers. We also were able to take a field trip to the First Peoples Buffalo Jump in Ulm. It was very interesting. My class made posters and presented them to the school board when they visited our school.

We will be continuing to build upon these projects using Clips videos and iMovie as we move forward in the school year.
