#### **Visual Arts**

NIS ART- 3rd/4th- Students are creating dragons inspired by the book "Dragons love Tacos". We are using tempera paint to paint and create this 2 day project. We will paint our Dragons on the second day of this project. They are learning about line, shape, form, color and texture.
