One District

- 1. Teacher Appreciation/Staff Appreciation Week
 - a. May 4-8 is National Teacher Appreciation Week. In light of everything, we have decided to celebrate and appreciate every staff member in the District. Amy Tollifson created signs for us that are placed around both buildings. Goodie bags were given to every staff member (or left in their work area) from the Administration Team, School Board and PTO. T-shirts have been ordered and will arrive soon that say LPGE Strong. These items are just a small token of appreciation that we want to extend to EVERY staff member in our District. Every staff member has stepped up, worked differently, thought creatively and went above and beyond what was asked of them, all for the sake of our students, families and co-workers.
- 2. Sixth Grade to Seventh Grade Transition
 - a. In June, current sixth grade families will have the opportunity to tour the Secondary School facility. Mr. Rud and Mrs. Cebulla will provide tours on an individual basis to any families that sign up. More information will be coming out regarding this process and schedule.

Elementary School

- 1. LPGE Stronger Together Parade
 - a. On May 7, from 6:00-7:00 pm, the elementary staff will be hosting a "drive by parade" on the West and North sides of the elementary school. Teachers and staff members will be standing in spots about 12 feet apart. Families will have the opportunity to drive around the school and wave at their teachers and vice versa.
- 2. Elementary Graduations
 - a. Kindergarten
 - i. Instead of a traditional graduation ceremony that Kindergarten students have had in the past, this year's Kindergarten students will receive their end of the year items including their graduation certificate, cap and year end video from their teachers.
