



Report for September 2025

September was a rather busy month for us with all of our spring programs resuming after the summer hiatus. In addition to the “tried and true” programs we’ve had for quite some time, we added; a water color painting class, Energy Smart, Estate Planning, and fraud Alert Seminars, our Annual Pentathlon, Chess and Rook. Each had limited success, but all proved to be beneficial for our participants. We continue to be a busy place for the active senior.

Speaking of busy, the 2024/25 fiscal year has ended for the Center, and I’m proud to state that we met (exceeded, actually) every benchmark in the contract. Per County criteria, 1398 Genesee County, 60+ people attended 20,039 events (average of 14.33 per person), however, overall, 1,628 people participated in 24,996 events. The out-of-county folks averaged the highest number of visits per person with 21.55. Another banner year for Vienna Township, and surrounding area, seniors. Thank you for supporting us and allowing this place to be a hub of activity for the “slightly” older population.

October 13th is a holiday for the Center, but thanks to the generosity of Dort Financial Credit Union, we are going to open our doors to local volunteers who will come to trim shrubs, power wash the building, clean where needed, and paint our Craft Room.
