

Windridge Elementary

Windridge Elementary School Community Council proposes the following adjustments to their 2015-16 school improvement/LAND Trust plan.

- Revise the action plan for goal #1 (reading achievement) to read as follows.
 - Administer DIBELS and Davis Drill-Down by the end of September to identify at-risk students.
 - Implement interventions to address at-risk students with the support of the ELA coordinator and Language Arts tutors.
 - Implement the Language Arts routines in all classes with fidelity.
- Under goal #1, add \$500 expenses for salaries to support delivery of online curricular materials (retain \$20,000 for classroom teaching assistants in reading).
- Revise the action plan for goal #2 (attendance) to read as follows.
 - Implement school and classroom incentives for increased attendance.
 - Inform parents of chronic unexcused absences and meet with them to explain the importance of regular attendance and how chronic absences are impacting their child's learning.
 - Address attendance issues with individual students and their parents early.
- Revise the statement of goal #3 (math achievement) to read "Increase whole school median growth percentile scores on the PACE report by 5 points in math and language arts by reaching 100% proficiency on grade level priority skills by the end of the year."
- Revise the action plan for goal #3 (math achievement) to read as follows.
 - Communicate skills to all stakeholders.
 - Monitor progress toward proficiency using common grade level assessments at the end of each term.
 - Report progress toward proficiency quarterly at SEP conferences.
 - Provide intervention or enrichment to students who are below or above target line.
- Under goal #3, add \$500 expenses for salaries to support delivery of online curricular materials
- Revise the statement of goal #4 (quality staffing) to read "Refine intervention and enrichment strategies to meet the needs of individual students."
- Revise the action plan for goal #4 (quality staffing) to read as follows:
 - Creation of PLC Leadership Team that will receive and then provide training to each teacher through peer coaching.
 - Collaborate in Professional Learning Communities to identify essential standards, assess student learning, and respond with re-teaching and enrichment
 - Provide tutors trained to assist in intervention and enrichment based on student need.
 - Professional development on enrichment and higher level thinking strategies.
 - Provide updated technology including projectors, iPad stands and document cameras, iPad mini lab to support enriched Language Arts and Math instruction.
- Reduce Salary & Benefits planned expenses by \$1,000 by adjusting teacher assistant hours.

The overall budget was not adjusted.
