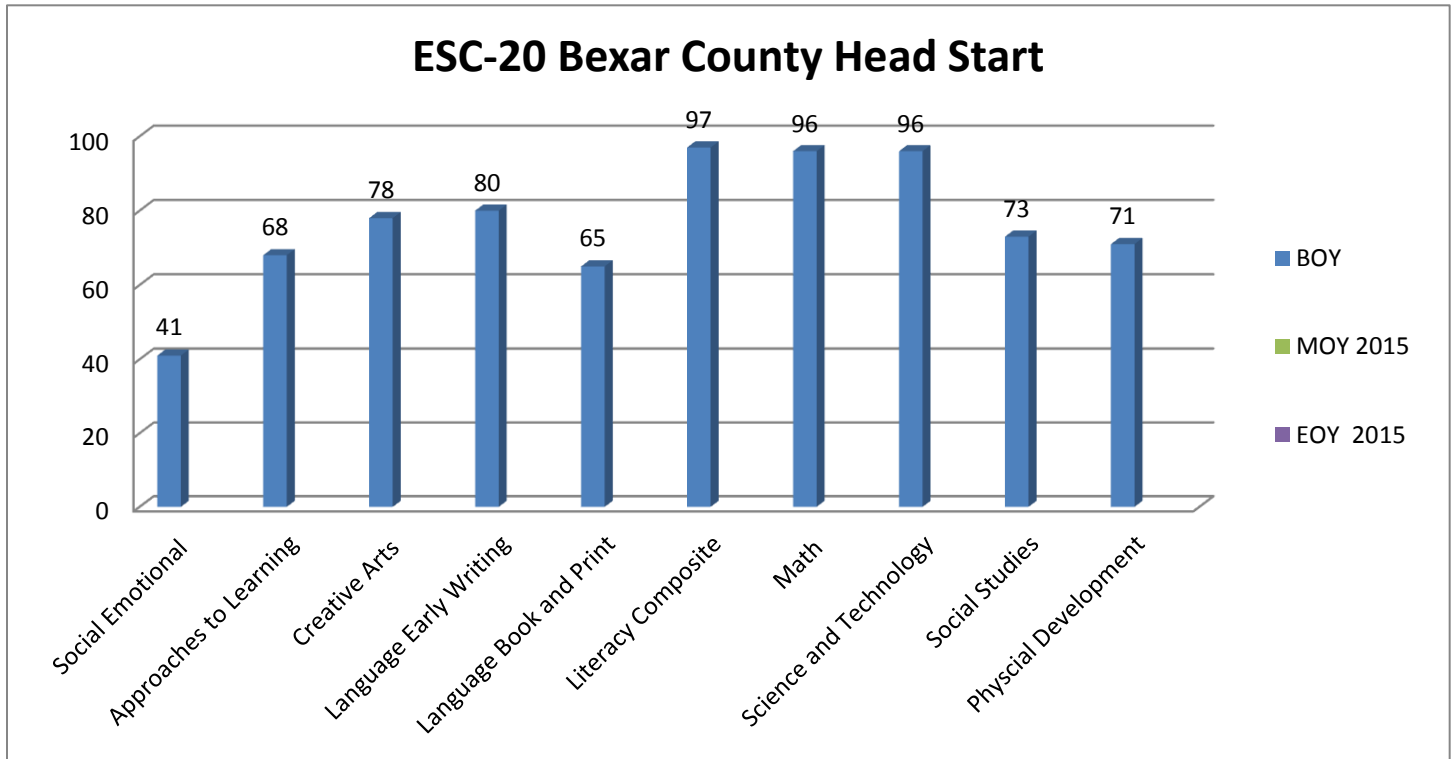


Overall Program Results

The data table below provides the overall program wide results, of the Beginning of the Year submission using the M-CLASS assessment, an additional report will be submitted in March 2015, and in May 2015, to analyze and monitor the overall progress towards meeting the School Readiness Goals:



Summary: The data table represents the progress of about 600 children assessed for the Beginning of the Year report during the fall submission, in all of the required 10 domains as required by the Office of Head Start. The data graphs in the areas of Social Emotional, Approaches to Learning, Creative Arts, Language Early Writing, Language Book and Print, Social Studies and Physical Development are **the average observable scores** recorded by the teacher's observations. The data graphs for Literacy Composite, Math and Science demonstrate the **percent of children proficient** in meeting the appropriate standards required in those domains.

Teachers will analyze data along with the School Readiness Specialist to establish strategies to assist children in becoming proficient, and in planning for small group instruction through hands on learning activities.

Parent Family Community Engagement Activities are sent home monthly to engage parents in the learning process to strengthen the parent - school connection.
