Our progressive program offers classes from age 6 months and up and will help you feel comfortable and confident in the water. Parent/Child classes promote water safety and water adjustment in a fun, safe and secure learning environment; one parent must accompany each child during these lessons. Preschool lessons are designed for children ages 4-6 to participate without a parent. Levels 1-7 are for children age 6 and older; these lessons are based on skill progression.
