BUDGETARY BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

Annual budgets are adopted for all government fund types, except for capital projects funds which are prepared on a project by project basis.

The Board of Education holds a public hearing and a final budget must be prepared and adopted no later than September 30.

BUDGETARY BASIS

▶ The budget is developed within the guidelines predicated by the Illinois State Board of Education and is organized into a series of accounts called funds.

▶ Total revenue for all funds for the school district is estimated at \$115,981,917 and total expenditure appropriations amount to \$103,532,262.

- The 2016-2017 budget is balanced
 - The surplus is \$12,449,655

Oak Park School District 97 Preliminary Budget Revenues 2017-2018

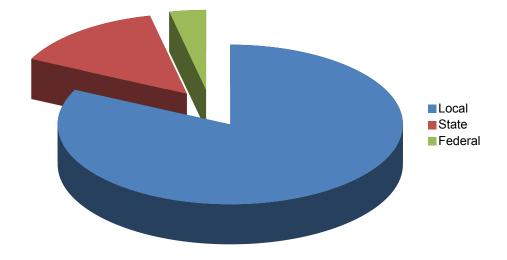

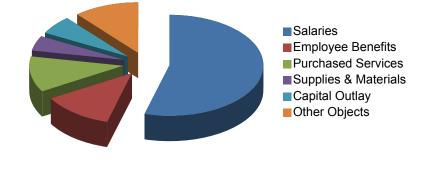
