**Subject:** RFP #F1088-25 Cafeteria Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment

### Background Information:

- On November 7, 2023, the voters approved a \$1,030,177,000 Bond Referendum including two separate Bond Propositions. The General Proposition included facilities maintenance, safety and security, and technology infrastructure-related projects. The Technology Proposition included instructional learning devices, teacher and staff devices, and enterprise applications.
- Included in the 2023 Bond Proposition are furniture replacement projects for multiple campuses. These projects focus on replacement of classroom, library, and cafeteria furniture.
- If approved, this RFP would be for an initial one (1) year term, with four (4) successive one-year renewal options, subject to Board approval.

### Administrative Consideration:

- Notifications were sent to 398 vendors, and thirteen proposals were received. Bids were evaluated and scored based on the evaluation criteria set forth in the Government Code.
- While funds are included in the 2023 Bond for furniture replacement, a percentage of the cafeteria furniture can be funded with Child Nutrition 240 Funds. The percentage is based upon the amount of use directly related to food service.
- To utilize Child Nutrition 240 Funds, the Texas Department of Agriculture requires items to be bid out in accordance with specific bidding requirements; this bid will be used for Board-approved vendors, with multiple quotes obtained for each project to ensure compliance with 240 Fund requirements.
- The remainder of the cost for the campuses will come from 2023 Bond Funds already allocated to the campus furniture replacement projects.
- Estimated Annual Expenditures: Total expenditures for this bid are unknown at this time, as it will depend on the availability of 240 Funds throughout the year and the usage percentage by campus. All purchases will remain within existing Bond furniture budgets and approved 240 Fund budgets.
- Best value involves considering several factors, which may include, but are not limited to, price, quality, availability, delivery timing, support, and other relevant factors. Awarding to multiple vendors does not obligate the District to make purchases.

**Recommendations:**

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the recommended vendors for RFP #F1088-25 Cafeteria Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment, and the related expenditures from both the Child Nutrition 240 Fund as well as the 2023 Bond Funds.
