LEGAL Policies

- LEGAL Policies are a reflection of law and do not require Board action
- LEGAL Policies are reviewed by the District's executive team for compliance, operational and regulatory adjustments



CAA - Fiscal Management Goals and Objectives: Financial Ethics

Aligns policy text with updated rules regarding federal grants found in the Federal Code of Regulations.



CDA - Other Revenues: Investments

Representatives with distributors of investment pools must be registered with the Texas State Securities Board, and other requirements.



CY - Intellectual Property

Clarifies circumstances under which the district's intellectual property may be used and where ownership of intellectual property lies when material is created by a district employee.



DH - Employee Standards of Conduct

At the section titles "Weapons Prohibited" new text aligns with our policy that authorized school marshalls may possess a firearm as part of the district's safety and security plan.

Provisions addressing tobacco and e-cigarettes are broadened to include any nicotine product, regardless of whether the product contains tobacco.



EHB - Curriculum Design: Special Programs

Updates policy to include dyslexia and related disorders to reflect changes in Administrative Code and references to *The Dyslexia*Handbook and ARD committee decisions.



EHBB - Special Programs: Gifted and Talented Students

Changes in the state GT plan, approved by SBEC required changes in terminology and revisions at Funding aligns the text with the requirement in the Education Code and Administrative Code rules.



FFG - Student Welfare: Child Abuse and Neglect

Requires reporters of child abuse and neglect to provide their name and contact information. The identity of the person will still remain anonymous.





GKA - Community Relations: Conduct on School Premises

Adds the prohibition of electronic vaping devices.
