A. Calendar of Events

B. Summer 2016 Professional Development- Curriculum Writing Projects

Lynne Viker, Director of Learning and Accountability, updated the school board on the various summer curriculum writing projects at each school and district wide. Wildwood Elementary staff will focus on the new language arts curriculum. O. H. Anderson Elementary staff will focus on language arts, 3rd grade math and special education projects. Mahtomedi Middle School staff will focus on language arts, science, creating a Google classroom in physical education classes and implement the use of Chromebooks in 7th grade American History. Mahtomedi High School staff will focus on language arts, art, new courses: Baking & Pastries, CIS French 4, Principals of Democracy, AP Chemistry, College Prep Algebra, American Sign Language 2, and a 21st Century skills Course, along with preparing for a new age 18-21 Transition Program. District-wide writing projects include alignment of music, art, family and consumer science and creating packets for families new to special education.

B. Approval of Resolution Relating to 2016-2017 Open Enrollment (Window #3)

Superintendent Mark Larson reviewed with school board members current enrollment numbers and what is being projected for the 2016-2017 school year and recommended denial of all Kindergarten students without sibling or employee preference, leaving 16 students on the waiting list, denial of all students in grades first through fifth grade without sibling or employee preference, leaving 10 students on the waiting list, placing all remaining 15 sixth grade students on the waiting list, approving 2 seventh grade students, approving 3 eighth grade students, leaving 2 on the waiting list and placing all remaining ninth through eleventh grade student on a waiting list. Grades K-5 and 12 are closed. Schwartz moved, McGraw seconded, approval of Resolution Relating to 2016-2017 Open Enrollment (Window #3). Carried 5-0. The school board will make final decisions on open enrollment at the August 11th meeting.

C. Approval of Policies

Chevalier moved, Schwartz seconded approval of the following policies: Policy 613 - Graduation Requirements, Policy 715 - Food Service Student Account Management. Carried 5-0.

11. SCHOOL BOARD COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. Association of Metropolitan School Districts (AMSD) Board

School Board Director Mike Chevalier reported on the May 20th AMSD board meeting where the 2016-17 budget and membership fees were adopted and a legislative update regarding schools was presented. There are two openings for board members on the AMSD Executive Committee for three year terms. They will be elected at the August meeting.

School Board Treasurer Kevin Donovan reported on MSBA's upcoming trip to Washington DC to lobby legislatures on special education funding, school lunches/nutrition and trust fund lands. School Board Director Judy Schwartz reported on the additional funding from legislature for teacher training at N.E. Metro 916 and on breaking ground for the new Pankalo Education Center in Lake Elmo.
