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

Halloween Costume Guidelines



As families are looking at planning costumes for Halloween, please keep in mind the following

- Please be sure that students wear acceptable clothing underneath the costume and that all ties/closures are accessible to the student in case they need to use the restroom.
- 2. Student must be recognizable, i.e. no masks or facial coverings.
- No weapons are allowed at school. Also no fake blood or gore.
- Safety & dress code rules still apply; if a costume is determined by a staff member to be a disruption in the classroom, a possible safety hazard, or inappropriate the student will be asked to change.
- 5. Spray cans, hair coloring and make-up will NOT be allowed to be applied at school.

#### TITLE ONE

Manzanita receives federal funds for Title One programs that are part of the No Child Left Behind Act. Throughout the school year, we will continue to provide parents with important information about this law and your child's education.

You have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher. When you request this information, the district will provide you with this information in a timely manner. You have the right to request the following information:

- A. If the teacher has met state licensing requirements for the grade level and subjects in which the teacher is providing instruction.
- B. If the teacher is teaching under an emergency status for which state licensing requirements have been waived.
- C. The type of college degree and major of the teacher and the field of discipline for any graduate degrees and certificates.
- D. If your child is receiving Title One services from paraprofessionals and, if so, his/her qualifications.
