TOPIC:	Adult Education Laptop Purchase
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RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of new HP ProBook Notebook Laptop Computers from CDW-G (Vernon Hills, IL) for the amount of \$57,473.40.

RATIONALE:

The Adult Education Program is requesting to purchase new laptops. This purchase is budgeted as part of the WIOA Title II Adult Education grant of 2024-25 already confirmed by the State Department of Adult Education to be awarded to LPS. Through contract pricing the total cost for 60 laptops will be \$57,473.40 through CDW-G (Vernon Hills, IL).

The new technology will be used by the Adult Education Students (ESL, High School Completion and Adult Basic Education) for daily classroom work as well as mandatory testing.
