 - B. School Student/Section Numbers Update: No Action was taken. Sherry Baker reported to the committee that the elementary has 20 more students than last year. We have 84 enrolled in 4k. Because we are a SAGE school we have to keep in grades K-3 at 18 students to one teacher. There are 13 seats available in the Kindergarten. Grade 1 we have 53 students with one seat available, in grade 2 we have all the seats filled and in grade 3 we have one seat available. We have one seat available in Multiage. We have a 3/4 class, we did that to accommodate S.A.G.E. Trisha Detert reported on the Middle School class size 6th grade is smaller class there is 74 mixed classes. Doesn't reflect special ed students. 7th grade largest class, 106 6 students out 7 moving in. 8th grade is on the high school schedule class sizes 20 and under. 3rd hour is enrichment. 84 students in the 8th grade. Shane Saari presented the high school numbers. Class size is driven by what the students pick. Overall class numbers are good.
 - C. Gifted and Talented Middle School Students taking High School Courses Information Update: No Action was taken. Trisha Detert reported to the committee that we have two Gifted and Talented Middle School talking with parent didn't want to follow the math regiment and now she wants to take a project lead the way course (engineering class) A pilot to know if they Middle School can handle a High School Class. 3 gifted students. Looking to offer to more to 8th grade.
