You have thirty (30) days from the date of this award letter to schedule preview of vehicles and equipment from the State Surplus Store located at 6506 Bolm Road, Austin, TX 78721. At this time there is limited availability of vehicles that meet the criteria for the HB229 program and selection is on a first come first served basis. Please note that select vehicles at our facility will be available for transfer through this program; availability of specific vehicle or make/model/year is not guaranteed. If your organization chooses not to take what we have available, your organization will be moved to the back of the line, and we will contact you when all other approved requests have been filled and more vehicles are available.
