SUMMARY: The Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) partners with public universities to operate Regional Security Operations Centers (RSOCs) to help protect government entities from cyber threats, such as hacking, malicious intrusion attempts, malware, and data breaches. University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Regional Security Operations Center (RSOC) launched in late 2024. The UTRGV RSOC provides free, real-time network security monitoring, threat detection, and incident response to local government, school, and utility entities across a 28-county South Texas region.
