












2025 Open Ended Response Summary

The survey asks four main open ended items to gauge families' perceptions of school culture and climate:

- 1. What do you like best about your child's school?
- 2. What do you like best about the Middletown Public Schools district?
- 3. What can be improved about your child's school?
- 4. What can be improved about the Middletown Public Schools district?

Across these four questions, the following patterns emerged:

Strengths (What Families Like Best)

- · Teachers/Staff (585 responses): Families consistently praised teachers, counselors, and principals for their care and commitment.
- Communication (236 responses): Many parents appreciated proactive communication from schools.
- Activities/Programs (197 responses): Families value extracurriculars, sports, and enrichment opportunities.
- · Student Support/Belonging (192 responses): Parents noted schools that felt welcoming and inclusive for children.

Areas for Improvement

- Safety/Discipline (175 responses): Concerns about bullying, discipline consistency, and overall safety.
- · Academics/Instruction (138 responses): Requests for stronger academics, alignment of teaching styles, and rigor.
- Time/Workload (128 responses): Families raised homework loads, school schedules, and after-school support.
- Facilities/Resources (51 responses): Calls for building improvements, technology upgrades, and updated materials.
- Leadership/Administration (48 responses): Families requested stronger leadership presence and responsiveness.
