TOPIC: Approval of Limited Schools of Choice Program for 2018-2019

## RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District accept the recommendation of the Superintendent to participate in Limited Schools of Choice under Section 105 \& 105c for the 2018-19 school year. Openings to include: up to 30 students at kindergarten; up to 15 students in grades 1-3, $5 \& 6$; up to 20 students in grade 4; and up to 18 students in grades 7 \& 8; up to 5 students in each Global Ed and CAPA in $9^{\text {th }}$ grade only; for a total of up to 171 students.

## RATIONALE:

Section 105 \& 105c Limited Schools of Choice will bring additional revenue to the district in the amount of approximately $\$ 1,368,000$ if all spots are filled and preserve programs essential to the students of Livonia Public Schools.

## BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

Added revenue to the general fund - up to $\$ 1,368,000$.
