**Re: Approval of Nitor Solutions Inc. for Silent Panic Alert Technology (SPAT) within the District**

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As CISD continues to evaluate, replace, and purchase equipment in accordance with HB3 Safety and Security Guidelines, we have a need to address the infrastructure and devices for a Silent Panic Alert Technology (SPAT) throughout the district. Our committee, which included transportation, technology, and the safety/security departments, have reviewed presentations and proposals from multiple companies and are recommending Nitor Solutions Inc. for your consideration.

Nitor Solutions Inc. has bid the SPAT project using Verkada equipment and devices within each building throughout the district. Each classroom will have a device installed in a common location. The security devices can also be worn by employees, if necessary.

The proposal from Nitor Solutions Inc. is being procured in accordance with Texas Education Code 44.031 through the cooperative purchasing method of procurement with BuyBoard. The entire project will be funded out of the state Safe Grant Funds – Cycle 1 funds.

**RECOMMENDATION: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve the proposal from Nitor Solutions Inc. for the purchase of equipment, infrastructure, and devices for the entire SPAT project for a total cost not to exceed \$900,000.**
