Re: Bid Results for 2018-2021 Pizza Lunch

I would like an opportunity to discuss the results of the pizza bid at the Monday, September 17, 2018, Committee of the Whole meeting. Please find attached a Pizza Bid memo from Pat Schuchardt, Food and Nutrition Department.

Domino's and Pizza Hut submitted bids in August. The two companies have a school lunch program that meets both the nutritional and other bid requirements. We recommend awarding the bid to Pizza Hut because their bid for pizza is \$0.75 less per pizza than the bid submitted by Domino's Pizza. Additionally, Pizza Hut has been supplying pizza lunches for the past two school years and the Food and Nutrition Department has been satisfied with their performance. This proposed contract will be for two years, with an option to extend to a third. Also included is a clause allowing the District to terminate at will. Due to increases in costs over the past two years, the new cost per pizza proposed by Pizza Hut is an increase of \$0.50. This will bring the estimated cost for the coming school year to \$171,750.00, which is an estimated increase of \$13,740.00.
