- At least 60% of ELL students tested must meet the standard for campus OR district to be rated Recognized or Exemplary *

Completion Rate & Dropout Rate

Completion Rate (graduates and continuers): no change

• Dropout Rate (Grades 7-8): will increase in rigor by decreasing to less than or equal to 1.6%. Will use 2009-10 data.






AYP District Reading
