



Domain 4: ALIGNMENT OF FINANCIAL WELL BEING WITH STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

Batesville School Is committed to following the UCISD reporting processes. Ensuring fidelity in reporting is crucial for accurate student coding and overall compliance.

Peims Campus Process

- 1. Monthly Review Meetings: Dedicated meetings for the administrative team to review student data
- 2. <u>Checklists and Protocols:</u> Develop for each team member to follow during the review process. This helps minimize errors.
- 3. <u>Feedback Loop:</u> Recognizing successes and areas for improvement can foster a culture of continuous improvement.
- 4. <u>Documentation:</u> Keeping detailed records of all reviews and corrections made can be useful for accountability and future reference.

Attendance Reporting Campus Process:

- 1. <u>Paper rosters</u> are handed out at 7:45 and collected by 8:15 to allow parent liaison to start contacting parents before attendance period (8:45-9:30).
- 2. Home Visits are made to unanswered parent phone calls.
- 3. Principal, Student and Parent conferences are held as needed. Schedule or unscheduled
