It has been a good spring for Homedale athletics. Excited for all of the district tournament action to start this coming Saturday, May 7th.

Baseball-

Varsity finished regular season play as the number 3 seed in the conference. Their first district game will be on Saturday, May 7th hosting Parma at 12:00. If we qualify for the state tournament, it will be hosted at NNU on May 19-21.

JV Baseball played well this year considering how many new kids they had on the team. There wasn't enough JV teams for a tournament.

Softball-

Varsity finished as the number 1 overall seed in conference play. Like baseball, higher seed hosts, so we will get to host any and all games we play in during the district tournament. Their first district competition will be Monday at 5:00. If the softball team qualifies for the state tournament, it will be hosted at Buhl High School on May 20-21.
