SUBJECT (item as it will appear on agenda): Add Course Fees – Computer Science

RECOMMENDATION: Approve \$15 course fees, effective spring 2019

BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

The curriculum in the Computer Science Network Administration AAS degree was revised to include discipline-focused tracks to better meet workforce demand and expand graduates' marketability after graduation. The four tracks in the curriculum include A) Network & Computer Systems Administrator Specialty, B) Information Security Analyst Specialty, C) Cisco Network Administration Specialty, and D) Network & System Virtualization Analyst Specialty. Presently, several courses carry a \$15 fee to offset the cost of instructional equipment and software. It is recommended to add a \$15 course fee to five courses in the revised curriculum, effective spring 2019. These courses include:

- ITNW 1375 Amazon Web Services
- ITNW 2355 Server Virtualization
- ITSY 1171 Mobile Networking and Security
- ITSY 2341 Security Management Practices
- ITSY 2342 Incident Response & Handling

Estimated Cost and Budgetary Support (how will this be paid for?): No cost. Estimated revenue is \$900 initially.
