#### I. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- A. <u>Recognition of Unsung Hero:</u> This year's Unsung Hero Award went to Beverly Hoffman, Administrative Assistant at the Middle School. Bev was chosen for her unfailing dedication to students, staff, and the community.
- B. <u>Important Dates:</u> 6<sup>th</sup> grade camp was mentioned in addition to the dates listed in the Board packet.
- C. <u>Preliminary Enrollment Figures:</u> Supt. Glaes reported that K-12 count is up pretty substantially. The W-A-Y count is up to 60 students. The official count day is October 3.
- D. Report on Opening Pre-service Activities and Ceremonies: Supt. Glaes reported that changes in teacher evaluation laws and the district's response were the topics of opening pre-service day. Principals explained activities in their building related to goal setting on day two.
- E. <u>Final Status of Open Positions:</u> Supt. Glaes stated that as of this time all teaching positions have been filled.
- F. <u>Reproductive Health Program Parent Notification for 2012-13:</u> Supt. Glaes stated that the annual Reproductive Health notification will be sent out to all parents within the next week giving them an opportunity to have their child opt out of instruction.
- G. <u>Legislative Update</u>: Supt. Glaes reported that a series of information meetings will be held in the county to inform staff members of elections they must make relative to the state retirement reform legislation.

## A. Financial Report – Steve

- 1. <u>Budget Progress Report:</u> Asst. Supt. Goss reviewed the budget progress report for August, 2012 showing total revenues of \$243,732; total expenditures of \$1,476,047; and deficiency of revenues over expenditures of -\$1,232,315.
- B. <u>Audience:</u> Steve Thomas requested details from the special meeting of September 4, 2012. Supt. Glaes explained that the Calvert Program is a virtual learning program available with a seat time waiver through KRESA for grades 6-8. The program will be used with home school students who also have the opportunity to take elective courses at the middle school. Mr. Thomas requested that special meeting notices be placed on the district website or another venue. The Open Meetings Act requires that special

meetings be posted 18 hours prior to the meeting at the main office. The Administration will make sure to post special meeting notices on the District website.
